ACTIVITIES FOR YOUR CG - THEME NIGHT

Here are some ideas for special themed nights that you and your Connect Group can check out and adapt from, whether it's for consolidation or simply to connect with your Connect Group members!

1. QUIZ NIGHTS

- Do prepare a few questions to catch-up with your members while the group is enjoying their favourite cup of coffee or tea! Some question ideas below:
 - i. What Singaporean food are you craving the most?
 - ii. What is your favourite memory?
 - iii. Is there anyone that you miss seeing?

3. DRESS-UP THEMES

- A simple way to have fun together as a Connect Group is to dress-up together according to a theme, and taking photos together to form memories!
- You might want to pre-empt your members a few days beforehand so that they would be able to prepare their outfits.
- Some simple dress-up theme examples
 - i. Colours: Picking a common colour to wear, or a specific colour theme such as pastel or B&W.
 - ii. Movies/TV Shows: Superheroes, Disney, Cartoons
 - iii. Decades: 00s, 90s, 80s
 - iv. Everyone wearing common items: Hats, Sunglasses

4. ACTIVITY TIME

- If your Connect Group loves to do stuff together, why not host a fun night where your Connect Group can connect over various types of activities!
- This can range from coming together just to hangout, to making things together!
