- Tell your parents and Small Group Leader about what you have decided to fast. Ask them to remind you about it!

# SCRIPTURE

Isaiah 43:19 (NLT) I am about to do something new. It is beginning to happen even now. Don't you see it coming?

# THOUGHTS

Everyone likes new things, like getting a new gift on your birthday! This verse says God is doing something new, but you need to make space for new things! Make room in your heart so that God can put something new inside. Open up your hands and say this out loud, "God, I am ready. Do a new thing in me!" In these 21 days, start something new – like reading this book every day and praying every morning!



Get your parent to call out a colour and time you as you look for an item of that colour.



Play a few rounds to see if you get better at finding the coloured item. Challenge your sibling or friend to see who finds the item the fastest!

If your parent told you what colour to look for 1 minute before they started timing you, would you be able to find the item faster? You probably would! That's because you would have extra time to get ready for it. In the same way, you can prepare yourself early so you would be ready for God every day!



# PRAYER

Dear God, I want to make room for You in my heart so I can receive new things from You. I want to be ready for You. Help me to prepare myself early so I will always be ready for You. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.

### REFLECTION

Circle 2 things you want to do this week to be ready for God to move:

Read a Bible story every night

Tell God how much you love Him every day Pray before you sleep every night

Sing a praise or worship song to God every day Say good morning to God every morning





























































**1 John 4:18 (ICB)** Where God's love is, there is no fear, because God's perfect love takes away fear.



Do you have something you are afraid of? The dark? Insects? Thunderstorms? Here's the good news! You don't have to fear because God loves you and He will take care of you. He will protect you, so you don't have to be afraid of anything! God will put peace in your heart when you call on Him. Whenever you feel scared, put your hand on your heart and say, "God, You are with me, I don't have to be afraid."





ACTIVITY

1. Grab a piece of paper and a crayon.



3. When you are done, show your parents what you are afraid of and pray together with them. Ask God to take away those fears and give you peace.

# REFLECTION

Read the Bible verse below. With your parents' help, think of some actions to help you remember the verse. Whenever you are afraid, do the actions and say the verse out loud. Remember, God is with you!

I am the Lord your God. I am holding your right hand. And I tell you, 'Don't be afraid. I will help you.' **Isaiah 41:13 (ICB)** 











#### DAY 7

# SCRIPTURE

#### Isaiah 41:10 (ICB)

So don't worry, because I am with you. Don't be afraid, because I am your God. I will make you strong and will help you.



When you feel alone, God is with you. When you find it hard to do something, God is with you. When you need help, God is with you. You are never alone, God is always with you! God promises to give you strength when you ask Him for help. Nothing is too hard for God! Do a superhero pose and say, "God is with me, I am never alone!"







# PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for always being there for me. You are a big and strong God. Nothing is too hard for You! Thank You for giving me strength when I ask You for help. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.

### REFLECTION

God gives us strength when we ask Him for help! Colour the bars on the battery with a green crayon. Fill it up all the way to the top. As you colour, remember that God is always there to fill you up with strength, just like charging a battery!





























#### DAY IO

# SCRIPTURE

#### John 14:16 (ICB)

I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper. He will give you this Helper to be with you forever.



### THOUGHTS

Imagine if you had to pour out all your toys and pack them back into boxes on your own. Would you want an extra pair of hands to help you? Of course you would. That is a lot of work to do on your own!

God knows you need help, so He gave you a special helper called the Holy Spirit! The Holy Spirit helps you when you are sad, when you are alone and when you are scared. God gave you the Holy Spirit because He loves you. The Holy Spirit is your friend. You can talk to the Holy Spirit and ask Him for help anytime!
