CONNECTING WITH SALVATIONS

1. Prioritise consolidation with salvations
 - 24-hour calls to be focused on salvations
 - 72-hour timeframe for calling guests
2. The more personal the connection, the better the connection is!

THREE STEPS TO CONNECT

1. Affirm

- Assure them that their decision to invite Jesus into their hearts is the best decision!
- Affirm them in their new identity.

2. Next Step

- Share how Next Step is helpful.
- Start on the spot, if possible!

3. Meet Up

- After making a connection, arrange to meet to continue Next Step!
