MAKING THE FIRST CALL

BEFORE THE CALL

- 1. Pray!
- 2. Refresh memory on the event the contact attended.
- 3. Write down some points you will cover (or have this guide before you).

DURING THE CALL

- 1. Show concern.
 - Check in on how everything has been going.
- 2. Address how you are connected to the contact.
 - Re-affirm salvation (if saved).
 - E.g. "Congrats on making this decision to know Jesus. This is more than a one-time choice, and there's so much more to knowing Jesus!"
 - Touch on the event the contact attended.
- 3. Offer help and encouragement.
 - Tell them you have been thinking and praying for them.
 - Ask if there are any ways you can help them (e.g. practical help, encouragement, prayer).
 - Pray for their needs.
 - Write down their needs so you can remember to pray for and check in on them later.
- 4. Arrange a meet-up to introduce them to Next Step.

E.g. "I'd like to catch up with you sometime soon! I would love to help you get to know who God is and what He has in store for you."

- Set a date as much as possible over the call.
- If he/she is unwilling to meet, enlist the help of the person that invited them.

AFTER THE CALL

- 1. Review any points taken.
 - Does his/her prayer request require urgent follow up?
 - Do his/her needs require any help which you may need to seek counsel for?
 - What specific areas can you be praying for before meeting him/her?
- 2. Update the consolidation sheet.
- 3. Set a reminder to check in or remind him/her of your meet-up date.
