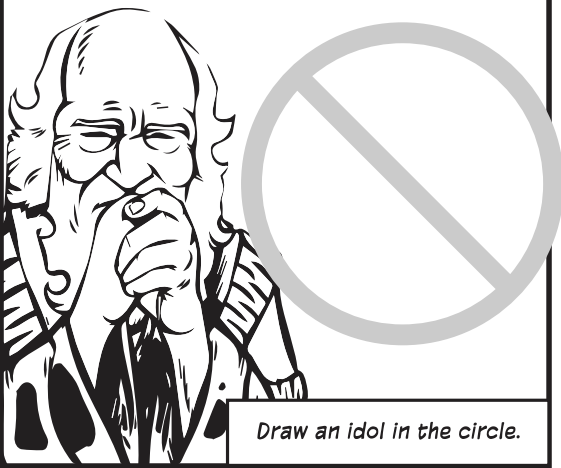

DANIEL WORSHIPED ONLY GOD



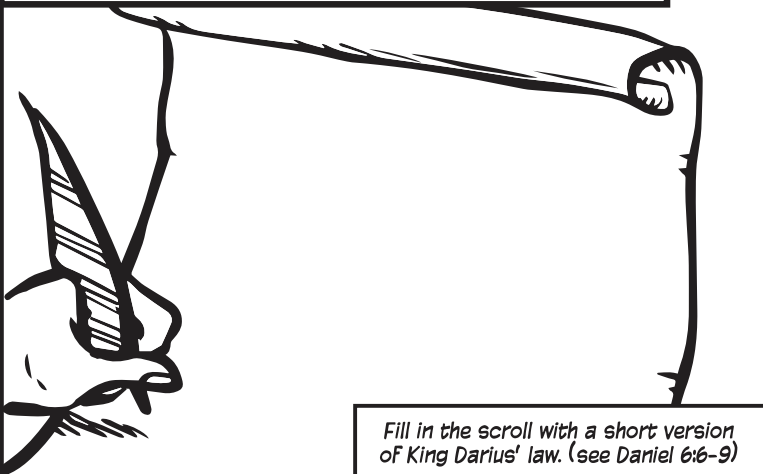
Draw an idol in the circle.

Fill in the speech bubble with something the jealous men were saying about Daniel.

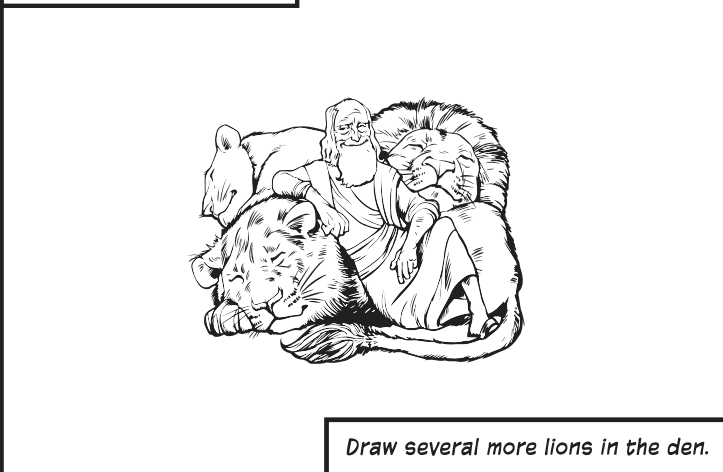
THE KING MAKES A NEW LAW... BUT DANIEL PRAYS ANYWAY



Fill in the scroll with a short version of King Darius' law. (see Daniel 6:6-9)

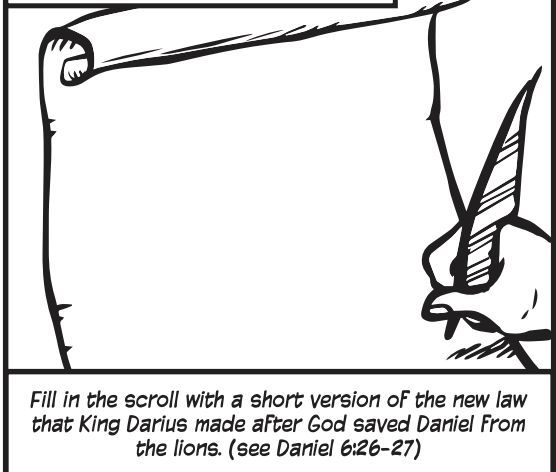


DANIEL WITH THE LIONS
