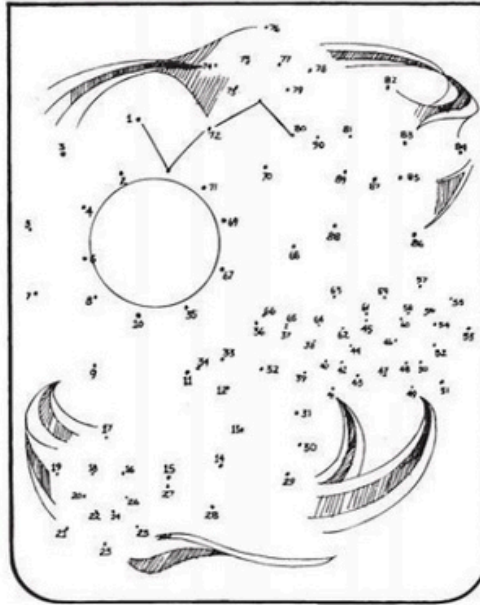

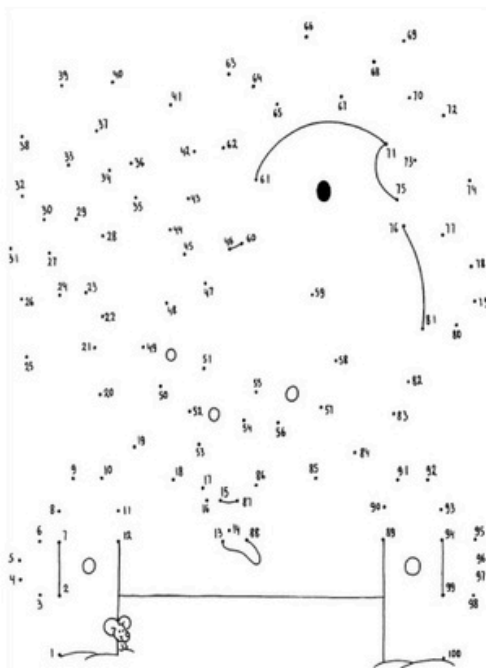
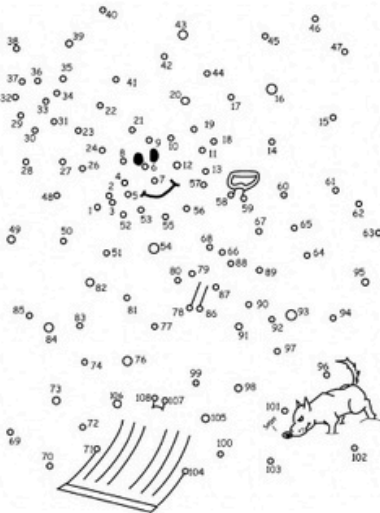
ORIGIN STORY

God made all these things on the fourth day of creation.

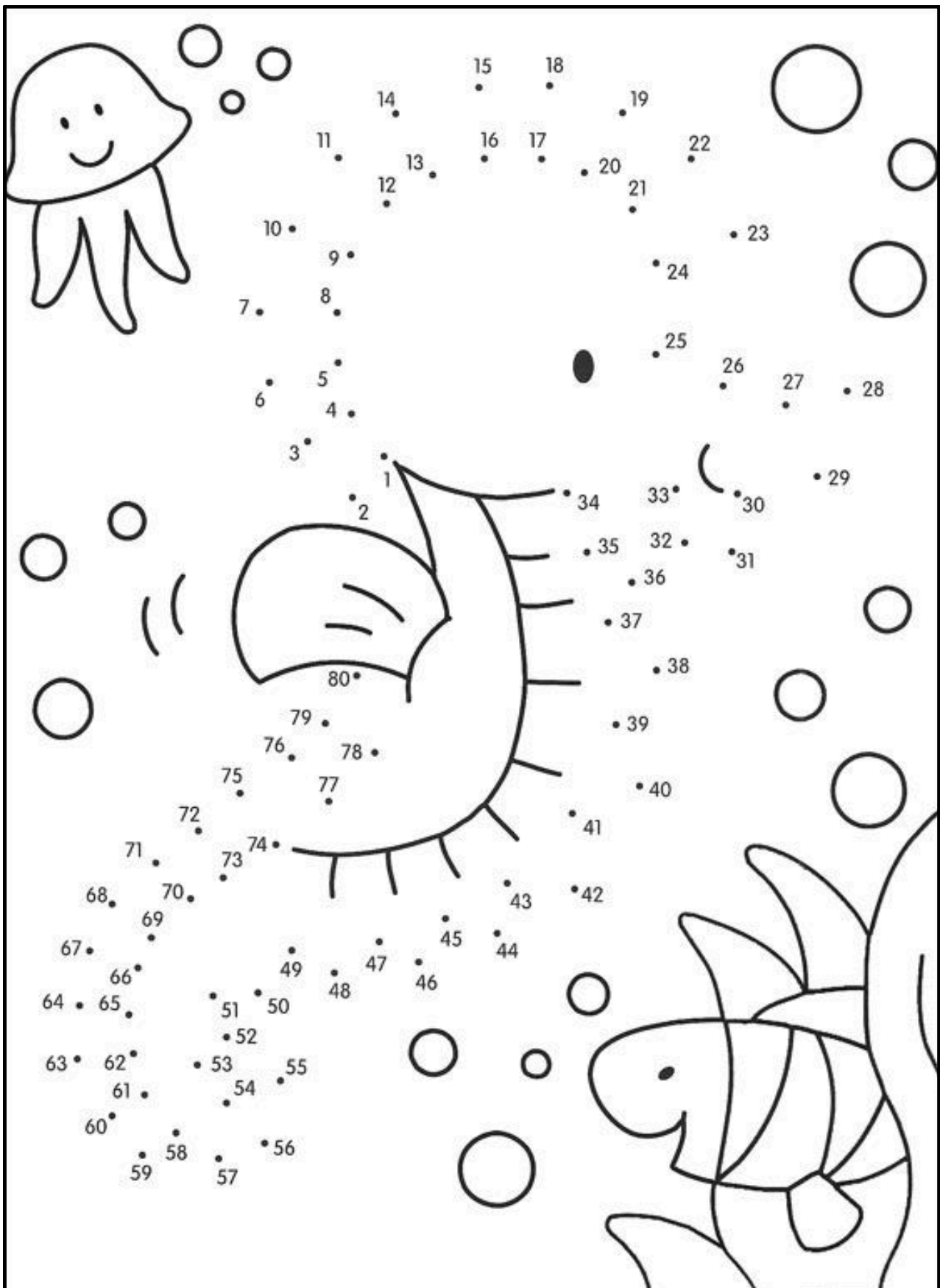
