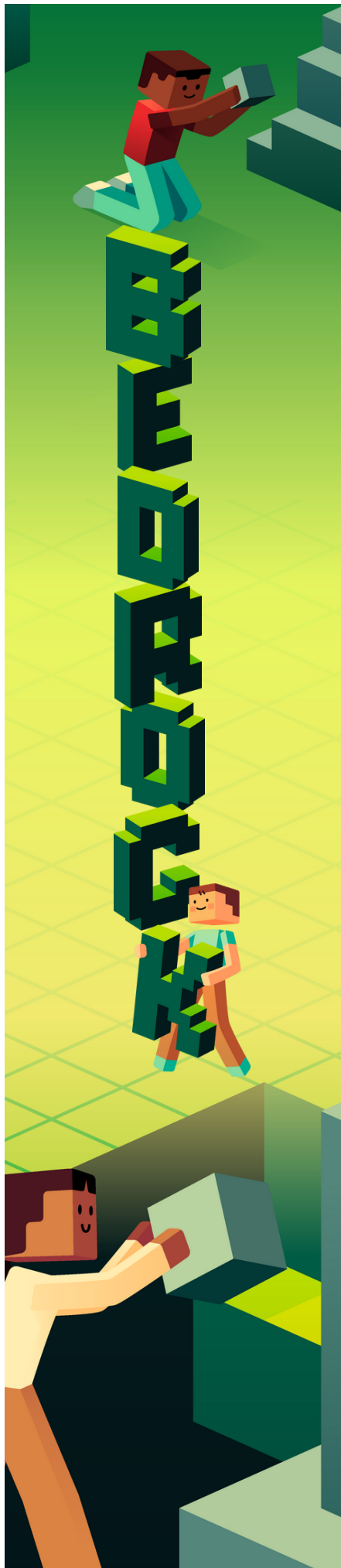
GOD CAN DO THE IMPOSSIBLE

Prayer and Reflection Part 3:

When things feel too big or too hard for you, remember that nothing is too difficult for God. Just like how Elijah trusted God, you can trust God to show up for you too! He is all-powerful! Invite God into your “impossible” situation and believe that He can make it possible.
