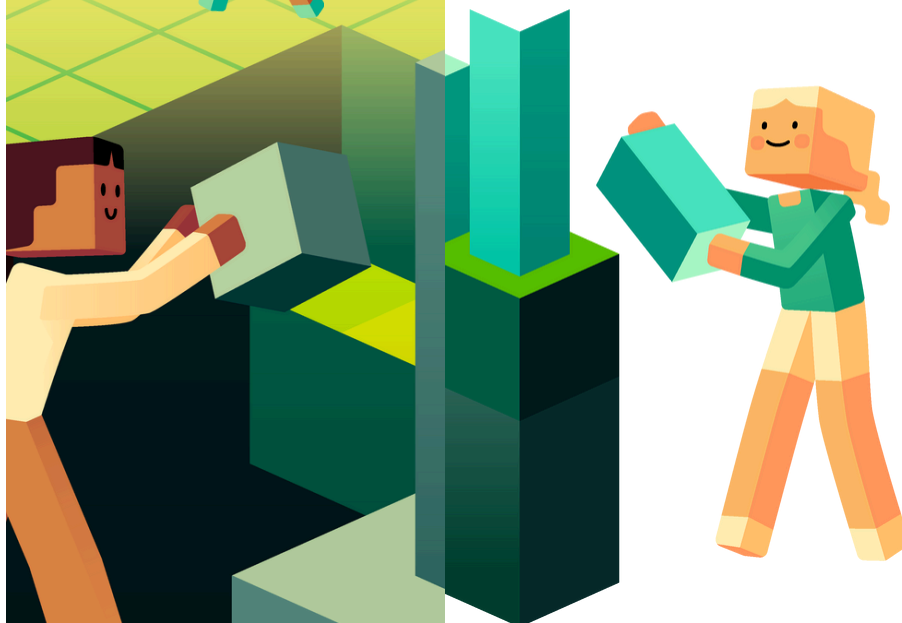
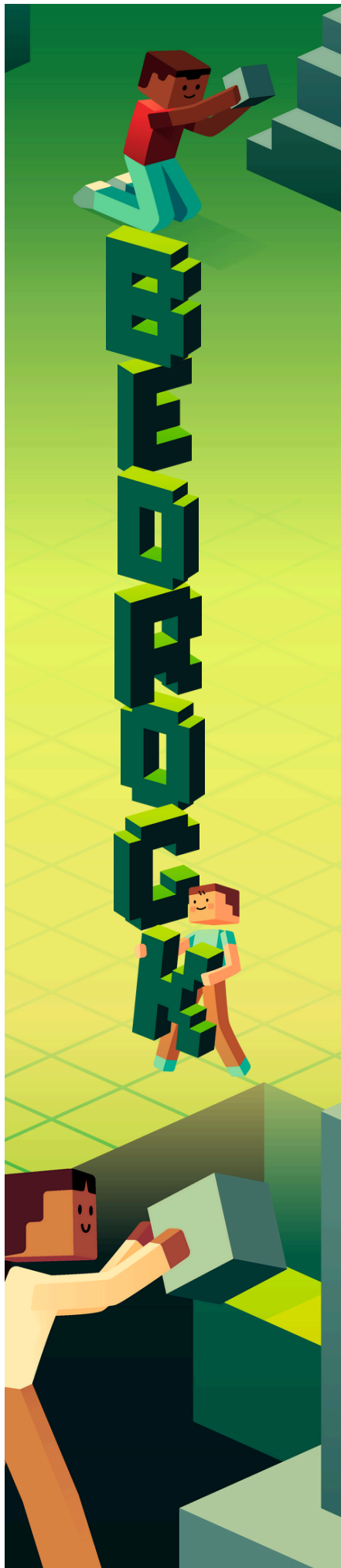

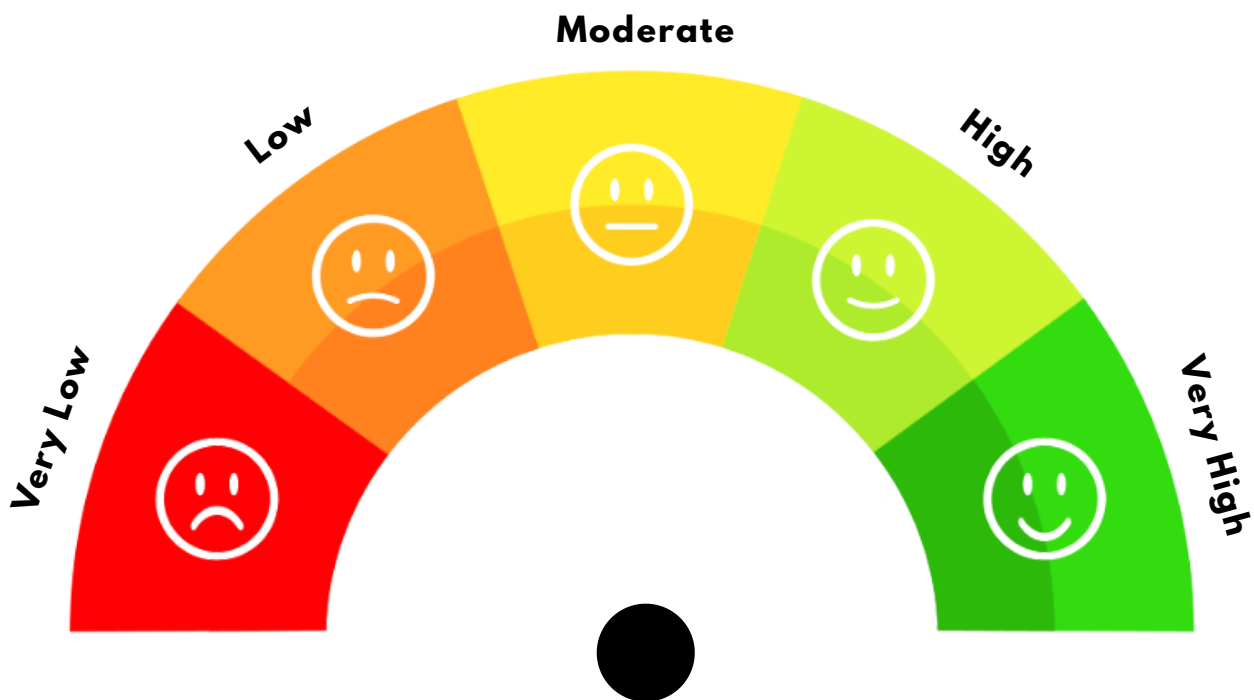

1) What makes it hard for you to trust God sometimes?

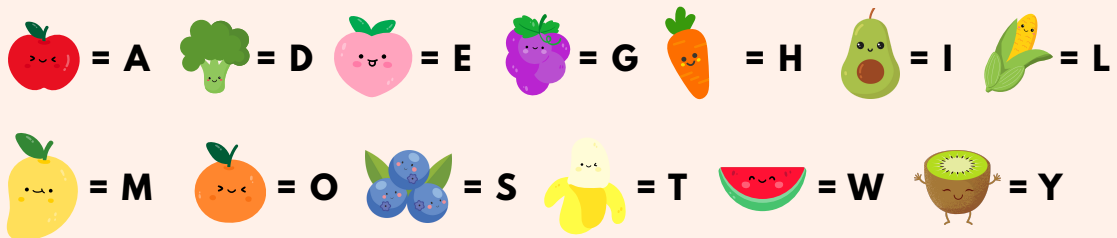
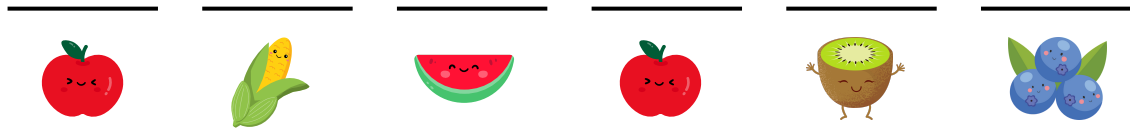
