Part 1:

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Part 2:

Just like how Solomon wrote some Proverbs and David wrote some Psalms, you can write poems about God too! Write a simple poem about God or wisdom in the blank below.



Start by thinking of 2 words you want to use in your poem (e.g. wise and heart).



Think of 2 other words that rhyme with these words (e.g. prize rhyme with wise, and smart rhymes with heart).



Write 4 short sentences, with the words you have chosen as the last word in each sentence (e.g. Help me Lord, to be wise. Wisdom is the best prize. Keeping Your word in my heart, that's the way to be smart!)

Now it's your turn, have fun writing! When you are done, share your poem with your Small Group.
