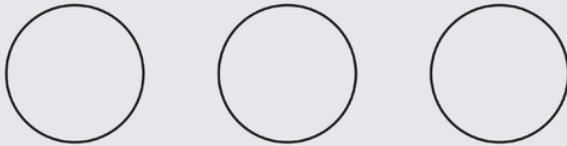
Read: Luke 2:11 NIV
