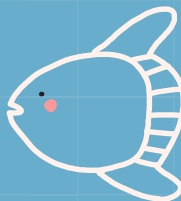

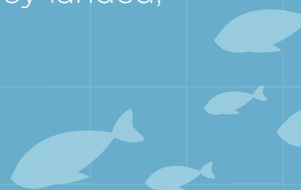
Luke 5:4-11

“Master,” Simon replied, “we worked hard all last night and didn’t catch a thing. **But if you say so**, I’ll let the nets down again.” And this time their nets were so full of fish they began to tear! A shout for help brought their partners in the other boat, and soon both boats were filled with fish and on the verge of sinking.

When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, “Oh, Lord, please leave me—I’m such a sinful man.” For he was awestruck by the number of fish they had caught, as were the others with him. His partners, James and John, the sons of Zebedee, were also amazed.

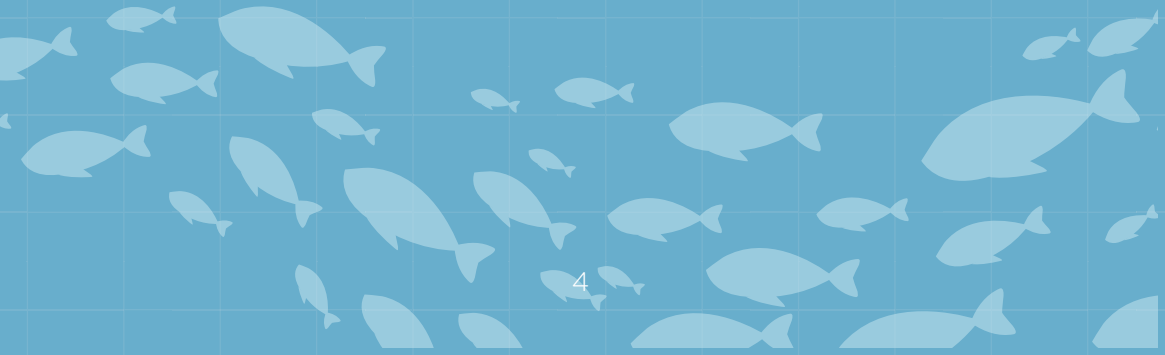
Jesus replied to Simon, “Don’t be afraid! **From now on you’ll be fishing for people!**” And as soon as they landed, they left everything and followed Jesus.

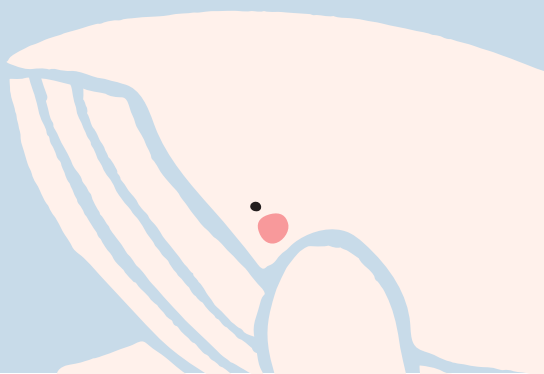
SHOULD I PRAY OUT LOUD?

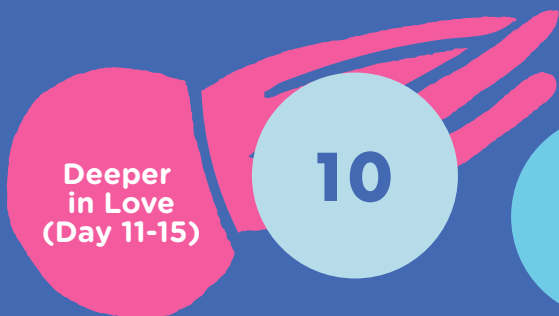
SHOULD I PUT MY HANDS TOGETHER AND CLOSE MY EYES WHEN I PRAY?

Day 1

CLOSER THAN YOU THINK

*"In those days when you pray, I will listen.
If you look for me wholeheartedly, you
will find me. I will be found by you,"
says the Lord.*

Jeremiah 29:12-14

Think about your best friend. When you want to share something exciting or tell him/her about your day, what would you do? Yes, you would call him/her, or look for him/her. You would spend time together. That is what drawing close to God looks like!

In this Bible verse, God was talking to His people through the prophet Jeremiah. His people were going through a tough time. They were far from home and far from God. God reminded them that if they looked for Him with their whole heart, they would find Him. God was not hiding! He was waiting for them to come closer to Him. God loves His people!

God loves you too. He wants to be close to you. You can make time and space for God by choosing a time every day to pray, read the Bible, or worship. Take a step closer to God today! He promises to meet you wherever you are.

Here are some ways you can draw close to God.

PRAYER TIME

Talk to God about everything! How your day went, your worries, your dreams, and even the fun stuff like your favourite games or best friends!

Example: "Dear God, I felt nervous about my test today, but I know You were with me. Thanks God!"

BIBLE READING

Read one verse a day. Think about what God is saying to you.

Write or draw a picture about what you learnt!

WORSHIP

Sing a song to God. You can find some praise & worship songs on VK's Spotify.



You could even write your own song or poem to tell God how awesome He is!

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Tell God that you want to draw close to Him.
- 2 Thank Him for His love.
- 3 Tell Him that you love Him too!



Day 2

BEST PLACE EVER

The one thing I ask of the Lord, the thing I seek most is to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, delighting in the Lord's perfections and meditating in his Temple. My heart has heard you say, "Come and talk with me." And my heart responds, "Lord, I am coming."

Psalm 27: 4, 8



In this Psalm that King David wrote, he said the most important thing to him was being with God. He wanted to be close to God all the time!

God invites everyone to draw near to Him. When you say “yes” to God’s invitation, you get to enjoy God’s presence. Being in God’s presence is the best thing! It brings amazing things like:

JOY

It feels like a warm hug from someone who cares about you. You can have God’s joy even on your worst days!

PEACE

An unexplainable calm feeling, like someone dear is holding your hand. You can trust that everything will be okay because God is with you.

HEALING

God is all-powerful. He can heal any sickness or disease in an instant! Many people have experienced God’s supernatural healing while worshipping Him.

STRENGTH

God can give you strength and courage even in the toughest moments.

Simon Peter also experienced a miracle when he spent time with Jesus on the boat (page 3 key verse). You can experience wonderful things when you spend time with God too. Spending time with God is the most important thing you can do every day. When you draw near to God, He will draw near to you.



PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Thank God for his presence. He is always with you.
- 2 Thank God for the joy, peace, healing and strength that can be found in His presence.

Day 3

LISTEN UP



My sheep listen to my voice. I know them, and they follow me.

John 10:27

Following Jesus is an adventure! He will guide you every step of the way. Listen to His instructions. He knows exactly where you need to go.

In the verse you just read, Jesus calls you His sheep because He cares for you like a good and loving Shepherd. He is calling you to follow Him because He wants to lead you to safe places. You can trust what He says because He knows what is best for you.

Here are some ways you can hear God and follow Him:

Read the Bible

The Bible is God's Word. It tells you what to do. God's Word is like an instruction manual in a game!

Pray and listen

When you pray, you should also spend some time being quiet so you can listen to God. God wants to speak to you. He may show you a picture in your mind, drop a thought in your head or speak to you through His voice directly.

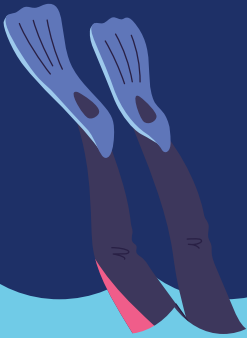
A listening ear is connected to a heart that is eager to know and obey Him. Set aside time to hear from God daily. Even if you do not hear anything the first time, you can trust that He is still speaking!

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1** Ask God to help you recognise His voice.
- 2** Thank God for being a God who speaks.

Day 4

YES AND OBEY



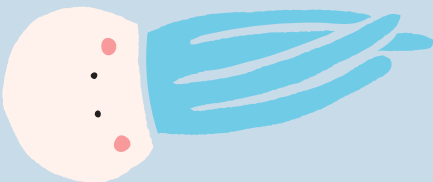
If you love me, obey my commands.

John 14:15

Listening to God is just the first step.
Obeying God is the next step.
God has many commandments He wants you to obey,
but these commandments are for your good!

The key verse on page 3 tells us that Simon Peter fished all night. He was probably tired, hungry and upset because he failed to catch any fish.
When Jesus told him to go back out and fish again, Simon Peter obeyed immediately even though it did not make sense to him. In the end, Simon Peter experienced God's miraculous blessing!

Obedience brings blessing. When you follow God's way instead of doing things your own way, God's goodness will overflow into every part of your life – just like how Simon Peter had an overflow of fish in his net!



Here are some examples of God's commandments which come with blessings when you obey:

Honour your parents

(Ephesians 6:1-3)

When you obey this commandment, God promises a long life.

Read and obey the Bible

(James 1:25, Luke 11:28)

God promises to bless what you do.

Put God first

(Matthew 6:33)

When you obey this commandment, God promises your needs will be met.

Eternal Life

(Matthew 19:17)

God promises to give The Holy Spirit to those who obey Him (Acts 5:32).



PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Make a commitment to obey God even when it is hard/when it does not make sense.
- 2 Thank God for the blessings He gives when you obey Him.

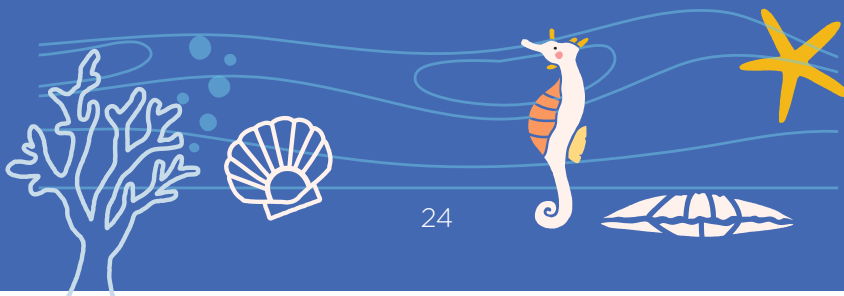


Day 5

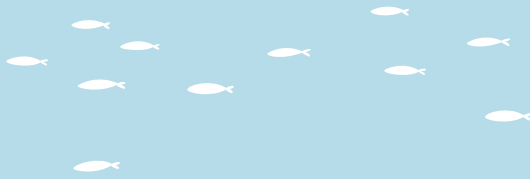

*Jesus called out to them, 'Come, follow Me, and I will show you how to fish for people!' And they left their nets at once and followed Him.
Matthew 4:19-20*





Having faith in God means trusting God completely. Trust is believing that God will take care of you, even when you are not sure how things will turn out. It is like sitting on a chair – you trust that the chair will hold you up even though the chair has done nothing to convince you.

In the verse you just read, Jesus called the fishermen to follow Him. The fishermen were not given a plan or any explanation. Yet they left everything and followed Jesus immediately. That took faith! They trusted that being with Jesus was going to be better than what they knew.

Trusting God is not always easy. Sometimes it means making a choice that feels uncomfortable, or doing what is right even when it costs you something. When you trust God and follow Him, you can be sure that He will take care of you and keep you on the right path. Let's go all in for Jesus!

PRAYER POINTERS

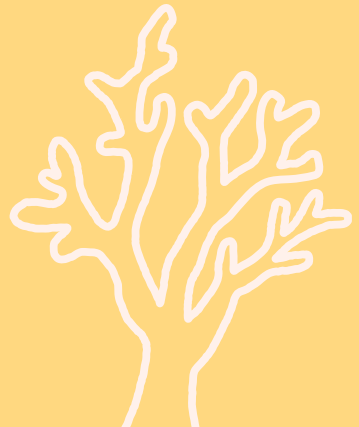
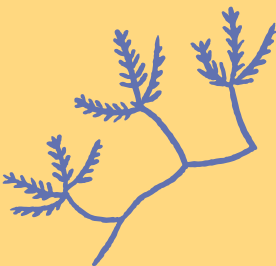
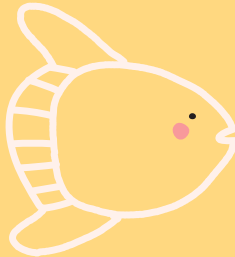
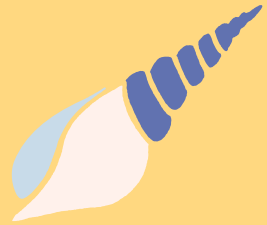
- 1 Thank God for being someone you can trust.

Day 7

TRUST WHEN IT'S TOUGH

'Master,' Simon replied, 'we worked hard all last night and did not catch a thing. But if You say so, I will let the nets down again.'

Luke 5:5



Simon Peter was probably feeling disappointed because he caught nothing all night despite trying his best. Yet, he chose to trust and obey what Jesus said.

Trusting God does not mean you always get the results you expect. God knows more than you do. His plans are always better (Isaiah 55:8-9). Even when you feel disappointed, you can continue to trust that God is working all things for good (Romans 8:28).

In moments when you tried your best but did not succeed, turn to God as your first response. Trust that God will turn things around for you. Your life will move in the direction of your strongest thoughts, so fill your mind with Bible verses, good thoughts (Philippians 4:8) and encouragement from leaders in your life.

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Thank God for being faithful (even when you feel disappointed).
- 2 Ask God for His peace when things do not turn out the way you want it to.

Day 8



TRUST BRINGS CHANGES



*Faith means being sure of the things
we hope for. And faith means
knowing that something is real
even if we do not see it.*

Hebrews 11:1

When Simon Peter chose to trust Jesus and obey what He said, there was a BIG CHANGE – from empty nets, to full nets!

What are some changes you would like to see in your life? Poor results to good results, quarrels at home to a loving family, sickness turned to good health, God can do all that! Nothing is too hard for God. (Matthew 19:26).

God may not always change things right away, but He is all-powerful and trustworthy. When you put your faith in God, He can do the impossible! The next time you feel stuck or helpless, choose to trust God. Pray and declare that He can turn things around!

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Declare that God is all-powerful, nothing is impossible for Him and He never fails.
- 2 Ask God to bring change in your life.
- 3 Pray for faith to trust God's timing.

Day 9

TRUST BRINGS HOPE



'For I know the plans I have for you,' says the Lord. 'They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.'
Jeremiah 29:11

Sometimes, life can feel dark — like when you do not know what the future will look like. In those moments, you may feel insecure or afraid.

While it is normal to feel those emotions, you can still choose to trust God. When you put your faith in God, you will find hope. Hope is like a light in a dark room, it makes everything look different!

Having a strong faith in God not only gives you hope, it can help others too. You can bring hope to others! You can:



Encourage a friend who is feeling sad or scared.



Pray for your family when they are worried.



Share God's love or remind someone that God cares for them.

The hope that God gives is different from the hope the world brings. Trusting God opens the way for His power to work in your life. Let's bring God's hope into every dark situation!

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Thank God that His plans for you are good and filled with hope.
- 2 Pray for courage to bring God's hope to someone who needs it.



Day 10

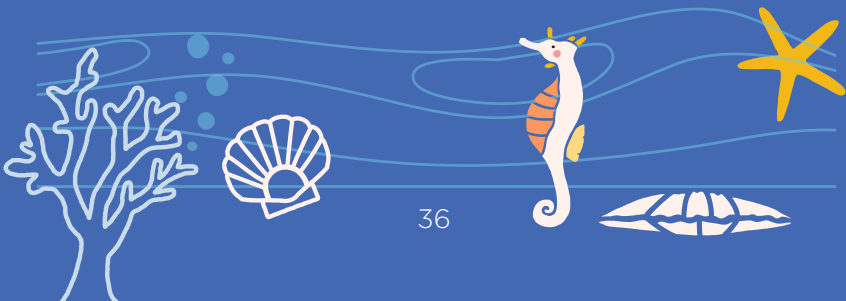

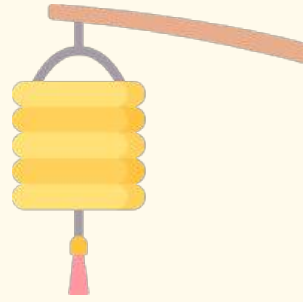

TRUST LANTERN



Over the last 4 days, you learnt how to grow deeper in faith. When you trust God, you are letting His light shine through you!

Materials needed

Lantern Activity Page (provided in pack)
1 Battery-operated tea light candle (provided in pack)
Scissors
Glue

Step 1

Take out the Lantern Activity Page provided in the pack.



Step 2

Cut off the bottom strip (cut along the dotted lines).



Step 3

Fold the paper in half and cut along the dotted lines.



Step 4

Open up the paper and add glue to the portion that says "glue here".



Step 5

Roll up your lantern and connect the 2 ends of the page together. Press down firmly.



Step 6

Add glue to the 2 ends of the strip which you cut out in step 2. Paste it on the left and right inner surface of your lantern (on the top of the lantern). Press down firmly.



Step 7

Take out the tea light candle provided in your pack. Turn it on and put it under your lantern.

Step 8

Switch off the lights in your room and watch how it shines. As your lantern glows, remember that trusting God is like shining His light in the dark.

Step 9

Pray this prayer: “Dear God, help me to trust You, even when I feel afraid. Let Your light shine through me.”

Step 10

Put your lantern somewhere visible in your room to remind you to shine for Jesus!

GOD'S



NEVER ENDING LOVE

And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is.
Ephesians 3:18



The world's largest ocean is the Pacific Ocean. It is about 165.25 million square kilometers (one-third of the planet's surface area). It is larger than all the earth's land combined! The deepest part of the ocean is about 11,034 meters deep – the tallest mountain would sink way beneath it!

Here is something even more amazing: God's love for you is bigger and deeper than that! God's love for you never ends.

God shows His love for you in many ways. He blessed you with friends and family, He gives you warm sunshine and cool breezes. He provides you with yummy food to enjoy. He listens every time you talk and thinks about you all the time. Most importantly, He gave you Jesus!

God is showering His love on you all the time, even when you do not notice it. God's love surrounds you, keeps you safe and calms all your fears (Zephaniah 3:17). Nothing can ever separate you from God's love (Romans 8:31-39).

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Thank God for His amazing love that never ends.
- 2 Ask God to help you see His love in the things all around you each day.

Day 12

WAYS TO LOVE GOD

*You must love the Lord your God with all your
heart, all your soul, and all your mind.*

Matthew 22:37



Yesterday, you read about how much God loves you. The correct way to respond to God's love, is to love Him back! You can love God in many ways. You can:

Talk to God

Tell God about your day, your dreams, or even your worries/fears! He loves to hear from you.

Sing songs of praise and worship

Tell God how much you love Him. Tell Him how awesome and wonderful He is!

Listen to God

Read your Bible. Pay attention to what is taught in church. Remain quiet and listen out for God.

Obey God

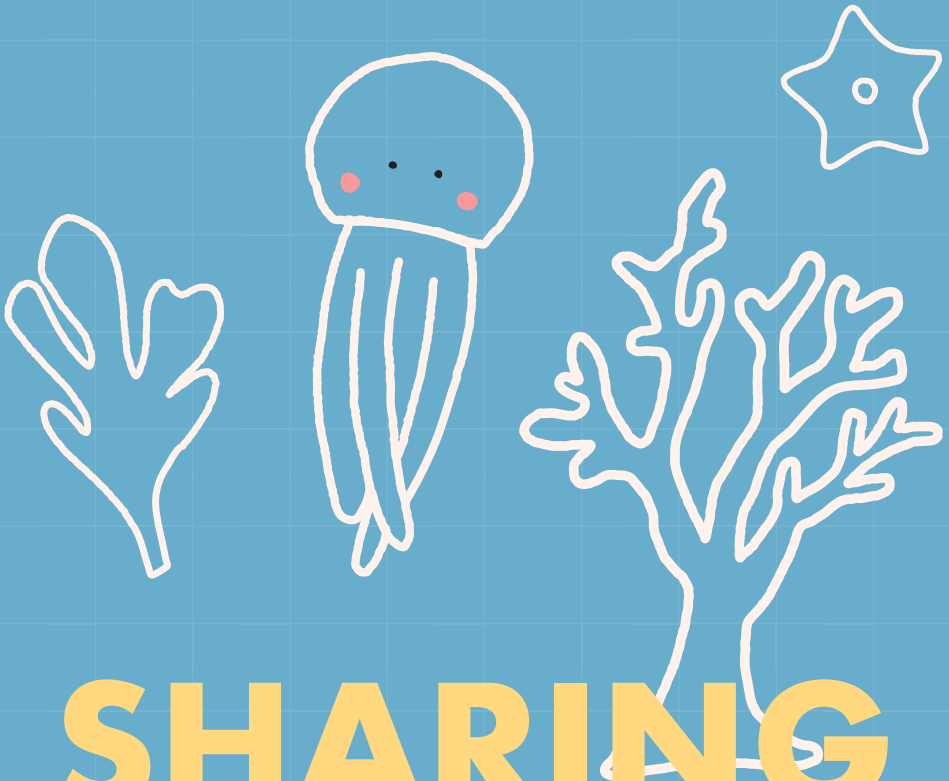
Do what God tells you to do, like being kind, honest and loving others.

Whatever you choose to do, big or small, it can be a way of loving God. God deserves all your love and attention!

PRAYER POINTERS

Day 13



SHARING GOD'S LOVE

*So now I am giving you a new commandment:
Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should
love each other.*

John 13:34

God wants you to love people, all kinds of people! Your friends, relatives, neighbors, even people you may not know very well. He wants you to share His love with everyone.

God has given you an extra special job: to reach out to people who do not know Him. By showing kindness and talking about Jesus, you can help people experience God's love.

This week, choose one of these 5 ways to share God's love with someone.

Help someone in need

Examples: Be a friend to someone who feels alone, give a gift, spend time helping someone run an errand/do a chore.

Pray for others

Examples: If someone is sick or sad, pray for them. Ask God to help them.

Be kind

Examples: Smile, say kind words of encouragement ("you can do it" or "I am so glad you are my friend"), include others in your games or activities.



Talk about Jesus

Examples: Share a testimony, read a Bible verse with them, tell them God loves them.

Invite someone to church

Small acts of kindness can help someone feel God's love. A simple encouragement or short prayer can go a long way and point people to Jesus!

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Ask God to give you opportunities to share His love with the people around you.
- 2 Ask God to tell you what to say and teach you what to do to show others His love.

Day 14

BETTER TOGETHER



*How good and pleasant it is when
God's people live together in unity!
Psalm 133:1*

In our key verse on page 3, Simon Peter could not pull in the big catch of fish on his own. He had to call his friends in the other boats for help. Together, they were able to pull in the nets that were full of fish.

That is what unity looks like! Unity means working well with others. God loves it when His children live in unity.

Here are some ways you can live in unity with others:

Share and take turns

Let someone else go first. Share what belongs to you.

Cheer others on

You can say things like, “you are awesome” or “I believe in you!”

Team up

Instead of working alone, choose to work with friends, classmates, or family members to get something done.





Invite others in

There is always room for one more in your group. If you see someone left out, include him/her in!

Be a peacemaker

If there is a fight, argument or disagreement, listen first. Seek to understand. Forgive one another. Help others make peace.

A united team is the best team! You can accomplish so much more when you choose to work with others. Let's build unity in the church and outside the church!

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1** Thank God for friends and family who help you, play nicely with you, and work well with you.
- 2** Ask God to help you be a good friend and a peace maker who brings people together and encourages unity.

Love God more.

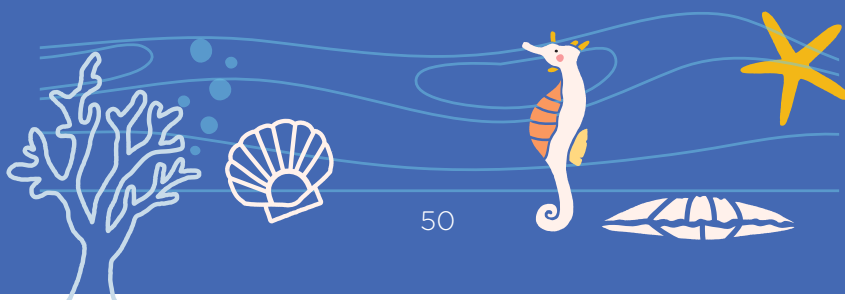

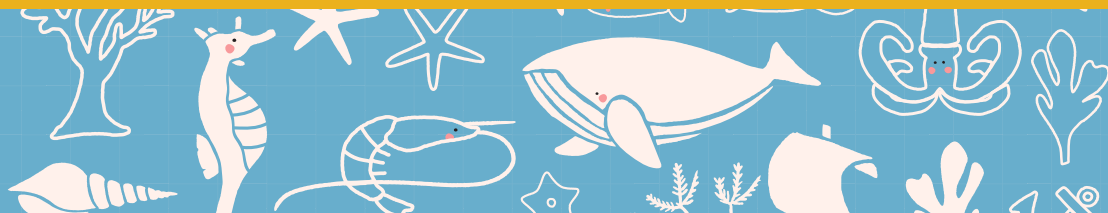

DIG DEEP FOR GOD'S TREASURE

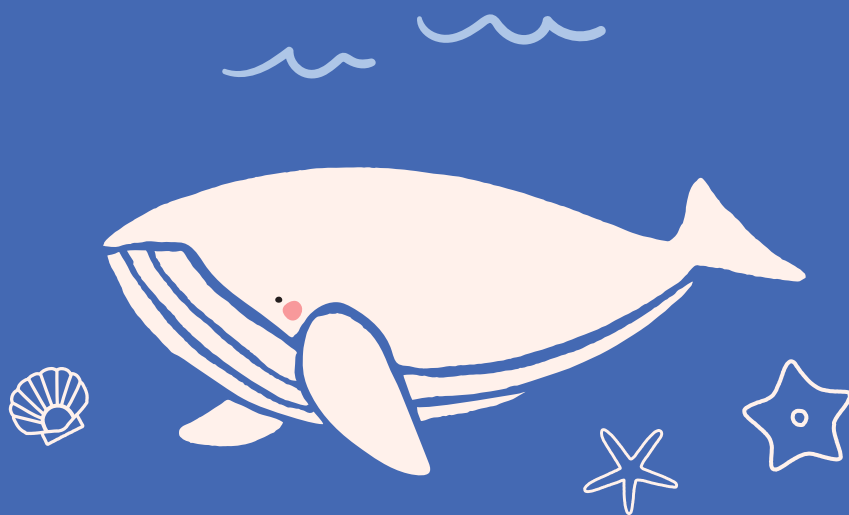
Look for it as you would look for silver. Search for it as you would search for hidden treasure. Then you will understand how to have respect for the Lord. You will find out how to know God.

Proverbs 2:4-5



Day 17

TEACHER JESUS



*Jesus said, "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord.'
And this is right, because that is what I am."
John 13:13*

In the key verse on page 3, Simon Peter and his friends knew Jesus as a Rabbi (teacher). After witnessing the miracle, Simon Peter recognised that Jesus was more than just a good teacher. He was God! That is why Simon Peter changed and called Jesus 'Lord' (Luke 5:8). Lord means owner. Simon Peter was declaring that Jesus was God – the owner of everything and the owner of his life.

Jesus is the ultimate teacher of truth, our wise counsellor. Whenever you need help making the right decision, you can turn to Him. But more than a teacher, Jesus is Lord over everything. Like Simon Peter, do you call Jesus your Lord? Is He the owner of your life? Are you willing to follow Him?

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1 Take a moment to praise God for being a miracle worker.
- 2 Ask God to give you a fresh perspective of who He is.
- 3 Pray using the word "Lord". Commit to obeying God.

Day 18

MADE FOR MORE

*With God's power working in us, God can do much,
much more than anything we can ask or think of.
Ephesians 3:20*

In the key verse on page 3, when Simon Peter obeyed Jesus, he and his friends caught what was more than enough for them. Their boats could not even contain the large amount of fish they had caught!

In the same way, God can provide more than enough for you and your family when you choose to obey Him.

God is calling you to do great things for Him! God wants you to represent Him in your family, school and neighbourhood. He will provide you with everything you need and more when you obey Him (Philippians 4:19).

PRAYER POINTERS

- 1** Take a moment to think about what God has provided for you in life. Thank Him for those things.
- 2** Thank Him for being a generous God who blesses abundantly.
- 3** Ask God to show you some things He would like you to do.

Day 19

TRUTH ABOUT YOUR FUTURE



But God chose you to be his people. You are royal priests. You are a holy nation. You are God's special treasure. You are all these things so that you can give him praise. God brought you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

1 Peter 2:9


In the key verse on page 3, Jesus declared a new identity over Simon Peter and the other fishermen. He gave them a new mission. He told them “from now on, you will be fishing for people!” Jesus wanted them to bring people into His kingdom instead.

Likewise, God has given you a special purpose: to live a godly life that brings Him praise. God brought you out of darkness and into His wonderful light for this reason! He has chosen you to bring others to Him.


