
# YOU CAN SHOW YOU CARE BY LETTING GO OF WHAT'S FAIR

## Week 2

### Prayer & Reflection

The story of Abram and Lot teaches us that we can make peace by letting go of what is fair. If the following action promotes peace, circle peace. If it promotes fairness, circle fair.



1. You won a board game and your friend gets upset. Your friend is just being a sore loser so you just let him/her remain upset.

2. You want to eat all of your birthday cake, but your younger sibling asks for half of it. You allow your younger sibling to take a bigger share of your birthday cake because you know he/she loves cake.

3. It is your turn to pick a movie for movie night. You choose your favourite movie to watch but your family members want to watch something else. You remind them that it is your turn to choose so they have to give in to you.

4. You choose to forgive a friend who hurt you.

5. You hold back your anger when someone wants to pick a fight with you.

6. You boarded a crowded train but managed to find an empty seat. At the next stop, an elderly man boards the train. You remain in your seat because you got the seat in the first place.

1. Why did you choose those answers?
2. Do you find it hard to choose peace and let go of fairness? Why?
3. Share a time where you managed to choose peace.
